



NANOPARTICLES OF CALCINED Ce-Co SUBSTITUTED HYDROTALCITE: CATALYTIC BEHAVIOR FOR THE REDUCTION OF N₂O BY NH₃

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Abstract

Nanoparticles of Co-Ce mixed oxides derived from substituted layered double hydroxides have been synthesized, characterized and tested as new catalysts in the process of catalytic reduction of N₂O by NH₃ in the presence of oxygen. The preliminary results show that high N₂O conversions are obtained in a wide range of temperatures: at 673 K the N₂O conversion is equal to nearly 50% and reaches a maximum value equal to almost 90% for temperatures higher than 750 K. In comparison, the catalytic sample derived from calcined not substituted hydrotalcite shows a maximum N₂O conversion equal to 40%.
